

What to Pack for Camp

Help your child pack so you both know what is being sent to camp. Please use discretion in your choice of clothing. Camp is the place for comfortable, loose fitting, old clothes. Keep in mind that weather can be unpredictable. Please send clothes for all types of weather (heat, cold and rain).

All campers need clean clothing for 10 days. Camp has a laundry service in town which provides weekly service per session. There is **NO CHARGE** to you for this service, however, JCC Camp Chi cannot assume responsibility for items lost by this laundry service.

Please label all of your child's belongings with their **FIRST AND LAST NAME.** We are not responsible for clothing that is damaged, lost or stolen. After Labor Day until the end of September, any items left at camp with names will be available for pick-up at the camp's winter office in Skokie.

- Cell phones
- Any electronic device that can connect to the internet, including computers, iPod Touch, iPads and other tablets, eReaders, portable games systems, etc.
- Other electronics, including DVD players, televisions, video cameras, walkie-talkies, etc.
- Food or bottled water
- Money
- Candles, incense, fireworks, matches, lighters
- Knives or weapons of any kind
- Hot pots
