IMPORTANT HEALTH CENTER PROCEDURES PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION INSTRUCTIONS

REGISTER WITH J DRUGS PHARMACY FOR CURRENT PRESCRIBED MEDICATIONS

To ensure the best possible quality of care in our health center, we require all campers who take prescriptions, supplements, vitamins and/or over-the-counter medications to enroll in a pharmacy service provided by J Drugs Pharmacy. This service ensures higher efficiency, lower risk of error, reduced waiting time for your campers and increased focus on their overall health.

We do expect 100% participation from families with campers who will need medication while at camp. The only exception is if the pharmacy notifies us that they are unable to accept your insurance or fill a particular medication. (Please see below on what to do if this applies to you.) **There is a \$100 fee for any camper who does not comply with this process and brings medication to camp on their own.**

J Drugs will package your camper's meds and deliver them directly to camp prior to your child's arrival. All pills will be pre-packaged in dose packs. J Drugs will manage every step of the process, including insurance payments, dispensing and delivery.

Please follow these instructions:

- Please print or use the J Drugs Pharmacy Order Form (on back).
- Please review the Parent FAQs in your CampInTouch account for any questions. You can always contact J Drugs at 718-258-6686 or by email at jdrugsrx@gmail.com.

- Fill out the order form and attach all prescriptions from your doctor to the form when submitting. If your child is ordering non-prescription items (OTC medications, vitamins, and/or supplements) a doctor's note or parents note is required.
- Mail (1205 Avenue J, Brooklyn, NY 11230), fax (718-258-1230) or email (jdrugsrx@gmail.com) the order form and prescriptions to J Drugs Pharmacy.
- The deadline for campers attending Session IA, Session IB, Take Two, Mini Session 1, Full Summer, SITs or all Camp Firefly programs is **May 15, 2020**.
- The deadline for campers attending Session II, Mini Session 2 or PNW is **June 15, 2020**.
- Any medications sent to J Drugs for repackaging will be charged a \$20 packaging fee.

All medication orders must be received 30 days prior to start of the session. All orders after that will incur an additional \$25.00 late charge plus any expedited shipping charges.

Please see the FAQ section on pages 2-3 for questions about as-needed meds, unusual supplements, liquid medications, controlled medications and more.

PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION FAQs

How much does this service cost?

J Drugs does not have any cost for their service, only the co-pay for your medications. If everything is submitted by the registration deadline, the cost should be the same as if you went to your regular pharmacy. If paperwork and registration are not completed at least 30 days prior to the start of your camper's session, there will be a \$25 late fee plus any expedited shipping costs. Any camper who does not comply with this process and brings medication to camp will be charged a \$100 fee.

How is my insurance billed? How am I billed for co-pays?

The pharmacy will bill your insurance company directly as prescriptions are filled. They are contracted with all major and most minor prescription carriers. Any out-of-pocket costs (e.g. co-pays, deductibles, over-the-counter medications, non-covered medications) will be charged to your credit card. If you have recently filled a prescription, you will need to request a "vacation override" from your insurance company. J Drugs will contact you with any questions about your insurance.

How are the medications packaged?

Medications are packaged in dose packs that include a detailed label with your child's name, date of birth, date and time to be administered, as well as any special instructions. A camp nurse opens the perforated packet and administers the medications to your camper. Only medications in pill form are included in the dose pack. All other medications will be packaged and dispensed separately.

Does J Drugs supply over-the-counter (OTC) medications, vitamins, and supplements?

Yes. They offer a large assortment of vitamins and nutritional supplements at a deeply discounted rate. The pharmacy will need a prescription from your child's doctor or a note from the parents for all medications, including over-the-counter medications, vitamins and supplements. This prescription should include dose, times to be given and any other detailed instructions. These items will be packaged together with your child's other medications. Camp Chi has over-the-counter medications available for campers' occasional use, such for headaches, stomach aches, congestion or fevers.

Can the pharmacy supply non-pill form medications such as creams, drops or liquid medications?

Yes. The medications will be included in separate, resealable packages with dosing instructions.

What about injectables?

J Drugs handles many injectables, such as growth hormones and insulin, but Camp Chi has chosen to allow families to package and send these medications to camp with their campers. Please contact Camp Chi if you want more information about the camp's practices for administering injectables.

Do I need to use this service for EpiPens and/or rescue inhalers?

If your child needs to use an EpiPen or Rescue inhalers, they can come to camp with your camper and do not have to be filled through J Drugs.

Can they package prescription medications my child uses on "as needed" basis?

Yes, both prescription and over the counter medications can be packaged "as needed."

Can a half pill be packaged?

Yes, your camper's physician must specifically write your child's prescription to be packaged as a half pill. You must indicate your request upon registering so the pharmacy can determine whether the specific medication is "durable" and is able to be split.

What time are medications dispensed as camp?

We dispense medications at mealtimes and bedtime. If your camper's medication is required to be taken at a certain time, please make sure your doctor indicates the times taken with the medication. Prescriptions written as "one pill per day" will be administered at breakfast unless otherwise indicated.

Will the pharmacy dispense generic or brand medications?

The pharmacy will dispense generic medications unless otherwise specified by your physician as "Do Not Substitute" or "Brand Only." Please notify your camper's physician accordingly if you do not want generic prescription or over-the-counter medications. For OTC medications, J Drugs will provide generics unless you specify otherwise.

What if my camper is at camp for longer than a month?

Most prescriptions can be written with refills. All controlled substances require an additional 30-day prescription.

What if my insurance requires 90-day mail order prescriptions?

You can contact your insurance company and explain that your child is attending camp and needs a 30-day prescription for pre-filled medication distribution. Most times, when you explain the procedure, they will give you a separate prescription for the summer. If you are having problems with this, you can also contact J Drugs for assistance with your insurance company.

My child is prescribed a controlled substance. How does J Drugs manage the limitations on filling these prescriptions?

J Drugs must receive an electronic prescription (or original prescription if your doctor does not electronically prescribe) for all controlled medications prior to shipping the medication. Prescriptions for controlled drugs will only be accepted for a 30-day supply. If your child is attending camp for a longer period, the doctor MUST supply a separate prescription for each 30-day period. Please have your doctor change the effective dates to match your session dates for the summer.

What if my camper's medication needs to be refilled while at camp?

If your camper is at camp for more than 30 days, the pharmacy will refill the medication and ship it directly to camp. Do not refill your camper's medication while at camp, as this will cause your insurance to reject the pharmacy's insurance claim.

What if my camper is started on a prescription or nonprescription daily medication after the deadline date to register and submit prescriptions has passed?

The pharmacy will work with you regarding late medication changes. Please contact them as soon as you are aware of any changes to your camper's medication regimen.

What if I have a supply of medication at home and don't want to purchase more?

J Drugs will package medications you already have for a \$20 fee. Contact J Drugs for specific instructions.

What if my camper is prescribed medication while at camp?

These medications will be filled at camp through the local Walgreens. Please follow our instructions about registering with Walgreens prior to camp. You can find this information online in the "Preparing for Camp" section.

What happens to the extra medications if my child is at camp less than 30 days?

All medication is packaged for a 30-day supply. All unused medication will be sent home with your camper on the last day of camp.

REGISTER WITH WALGREENS FOR NEW PRESCRIBED MEDICATIONS WHILE AT CAMP

If your camper is sick and our camp physician prescribes medication while at camp, it will be filled at the local Walgreens Pharmacy.

We ask you to work together with us and Walgreens in making the process smooth. Please register your campers with Walgreens and include your insurance information and credit card. If your insurance is not affiliated with Walgreens, getting a referral would be helpful.

If your camper not already registered at Walgreens, we ask that you do so at least one week before your camper leaves for camp. If you are already registered, please take a moment to check your account and confirm that the insurance information and credit card on file are current.

Please follow these simple instructions to register your child and insurance at Walgreens. You have 2 options: to do so in person at any Walgreens or register online.

1. If you chose to register in person, visit any Walgreens with your insurance and/or prescription card and a credit card. They will enter this information in their nationwide, secure database.
2. If you prefer to register online, you can go to the Walgreens website: www.walgreens.com.
 - Click on "Prescriptions" on the top of the page.
 - Click on the "Create a new account" button.
 - Under "Register with Pharmacy Access", click the green "Get Started" button.
 - Once you have set up your account, under the "Account Home", click on the "Sign up" button under "Add Pharmacy Access to Your Account".
